BLOOD™ Plasma Pak

Blood Plasma Pak is an add-on collection of new levels for Blood. In order to experience the extra features of Blood Plasma Pak, you need to have the registered version of Blood already installed in your system.

MINIMUM SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

Memory: 16MB RAM

CD-ROM Drive: 4X

Operating System: Windows 95; DOS 6.2 or better

INSTALLATION

DOS Installation

1. Place the CD in your CD-ROM drive (typically drive D:).
2. Switch to your CD-ROM drive by typing D: (or the appropriate drive letter designation) and press [ENTER]
3. Type INSTALL and press [ENTER] to start the installation program
4. Follow the on-screen prompts

Once the game is installed, type **SETUP** from within your **Blood** directory to configure the game to your system. If you are unsure which settings to choose, consult your computer or sound card manual for assistance. If you know you have a sound card and speakers but are unsure of the brand, select **SoundBlaster** for both **Music** and **Sound Card** as it's the most common.

Windows® 95 Installation

1. Place the CD in your CD-ROM drive (typically drive D:). Unless you have autorun disabled, the **Blood Setup** will start. If it doesn't, or if you have an earlier version of **Windows® 95**, continue with the following steps:
2. Click on the **My Computer** icon on your desktop
3. Click on the icon for your CD-ROM drive
4. Double-click the **INSTALL** icon to start the installation program
5. Follow the on-screen prompts

Once the game is installed, double click the **SETUP** icon in your **Blood** folder to configure the game to your system. If you are unsure which settings to choose, consult your computer or sound card manual, or right click your **My Computer** icon and select the **Device Manager** tab, which should list the necessary information. If you know you have a sound card and speakers but are unsure of the brand, select **SoundBlaster** for both **Music** and **Sound Card** as it's the most common.

If you experience problems running **Blood** in **Windows95**, you will have to restart your computer in **MS-DOS** mode. Click on the **Start** button and select **Shut Down**. Select **Restart the computer in MS-DOS mode?** and click **OK**.


When your computer restarts, follow the **DOS** installation instructions above.

IMPORTANT!

Windows 3.1 users must exit to **DOS** before installing **Blood**. Click **File** in the top left hand corner of your **Program Manager** window, select **Exit Windows**, and then click **OK**. Note that each time you play you'll have to exit **Windows** and then switch to the **Blood** directory (by typing **CD\BLOOD** and then pressing **[ENTER]**).

WEAPONS

The following weapons have new modes in the Plasma Pak. Please press the Alt Fire Key to get a new variation of the basic weapon.



INCINERATOR

This monstrous weapon launches a huge ball of flaming napalm at an extremely high velocity. If the initial explosion doesn't kill your enemy, the burning probably will. Best used with extreme caution, especially in tight areas. The alternate fire launches several napalm projectiles, covering a wider area but also chewing up a lot more ammo.

TESLA CANNON

This powerful prototype weapon packs a mighty load of amperage. Nikola Tesla would be proud.

Ammo: Batteries



LIFE LEECH

This artifact draws its power from the life energy of your foes. Run low on ammo and it saps your own strength!

ENEMIES

The following new enemies have been added to Plasma Pak.



ELITE CULTISTS

These blue-robed Tesla Cannon wielding cultists have been through special 'training' to make them very mean. Their armor protects them from electrical damage.



ACKOLYTE

These cultists-in-training lob dynamite at you. Keep your ears tuned for the deadly hiss of an incoming bundle.



PRIEST

These red-robed Chosen-in-training have started their transformation into what you once were.... The Chosen.



PODS

These many-tentacled vegetable patches have trapped many an unwary adversary. They spit a sticky vile fluid that is very difficult to shake off.



FIRE PODS

These abominations have roots that go down to the bowels of the earth. They spew lava and can do serious damage. Be very careful not to become fertilizer.

BLOOD TOOLS

Tools for creating art and maps for Blood are contained in the tools directory on the first Blood CD-ROM. You should run the install program (install for DOS, wininstall for Windows) and place the files in the directory where you installed Blood.
